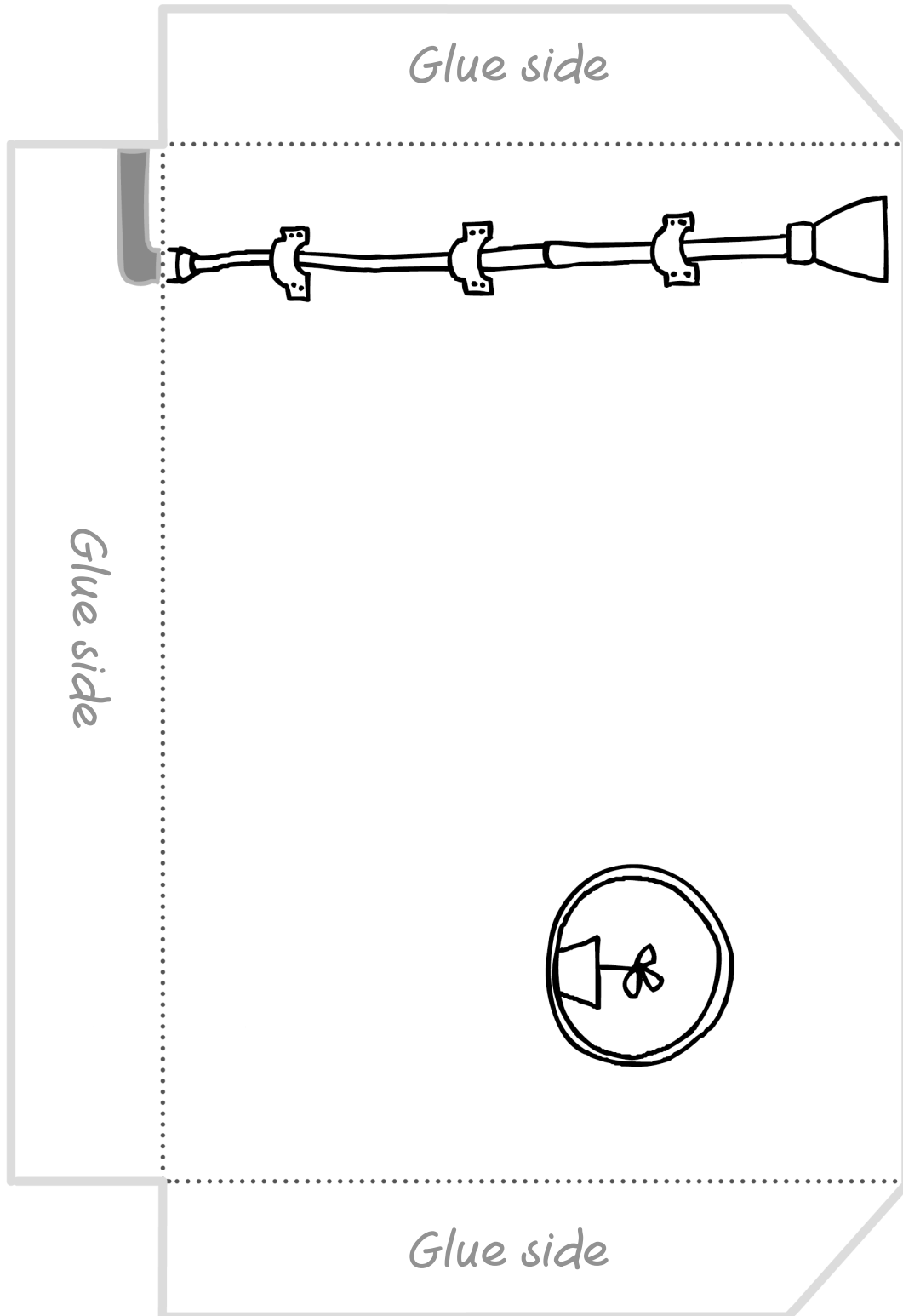

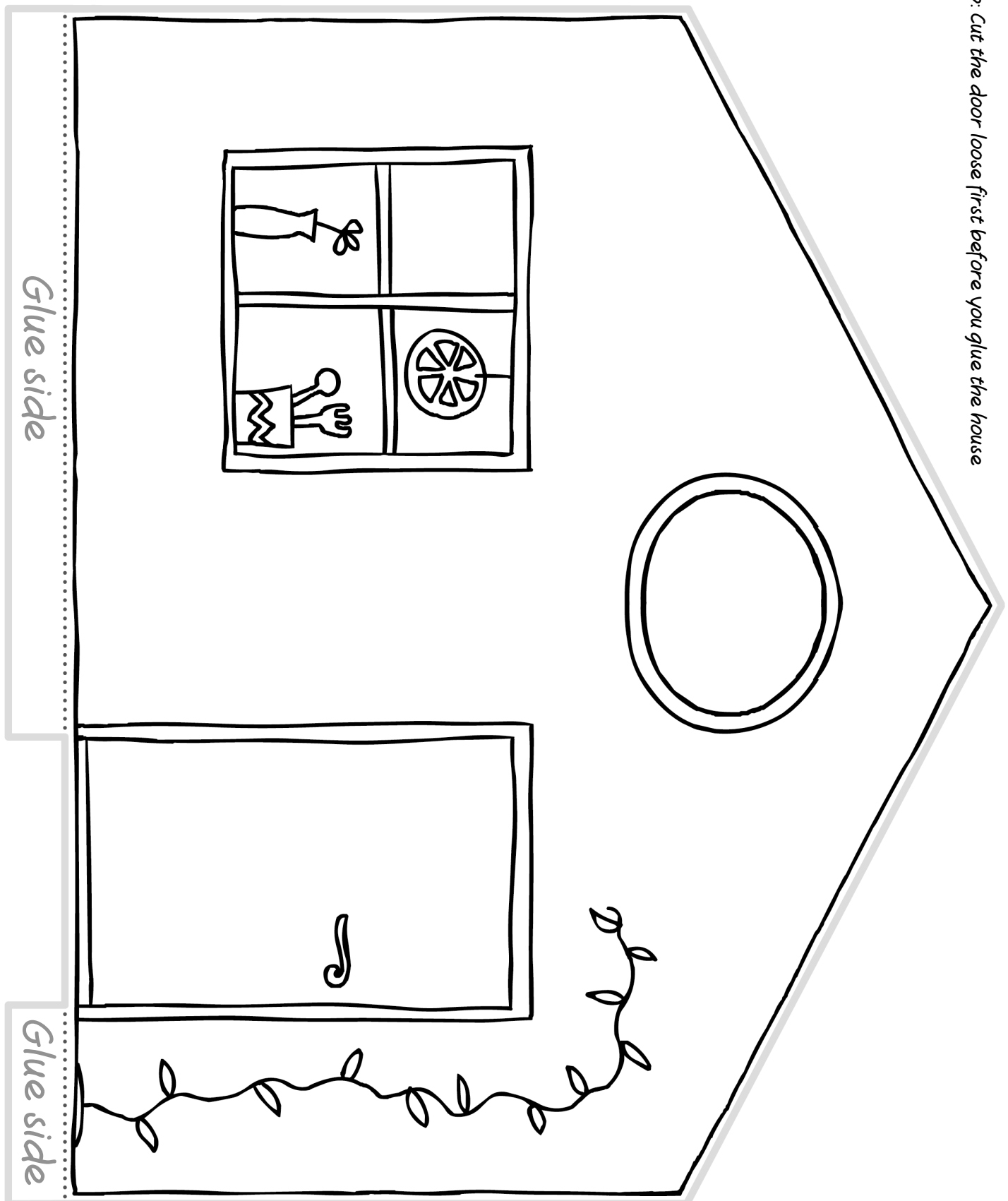

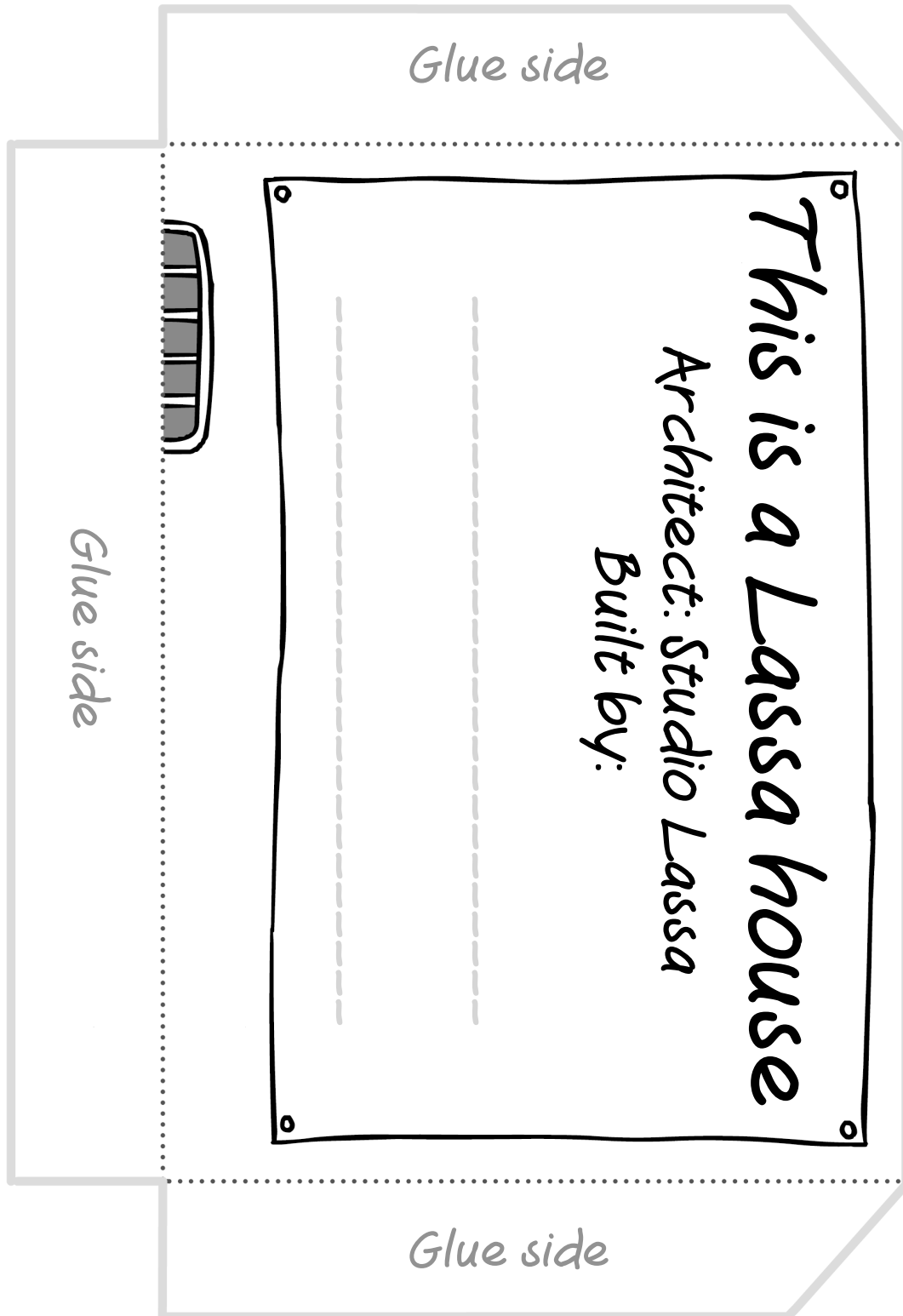

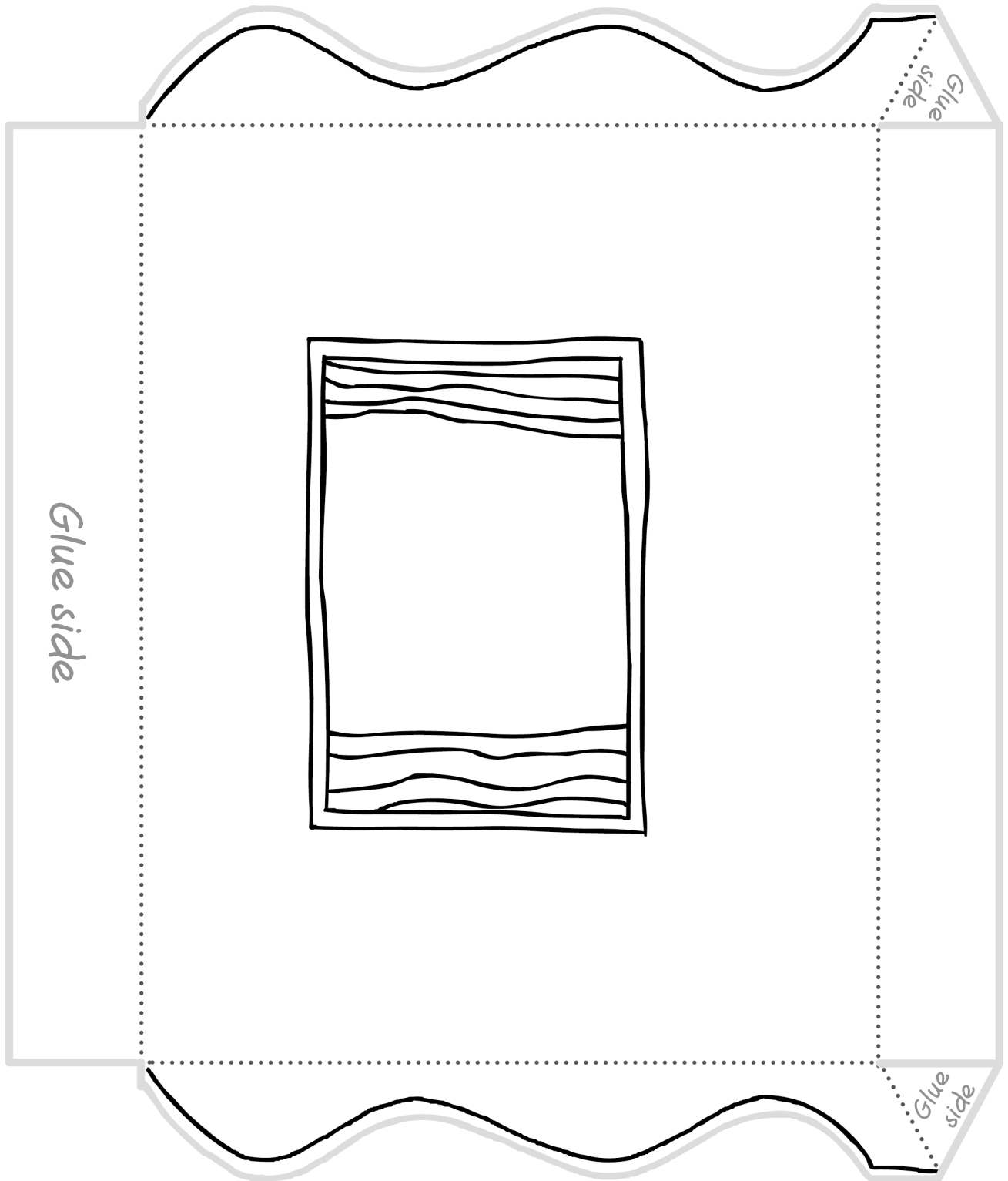

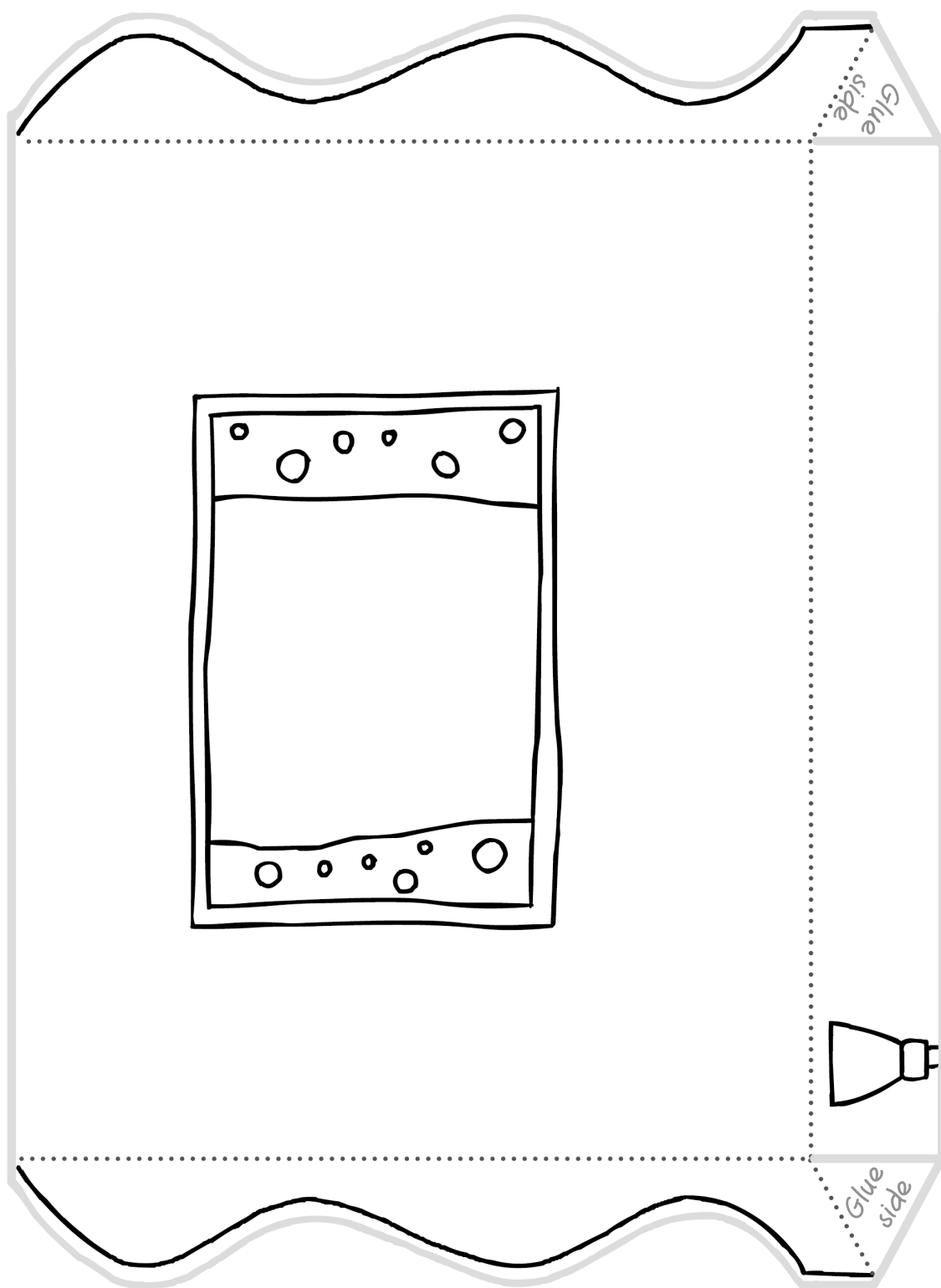

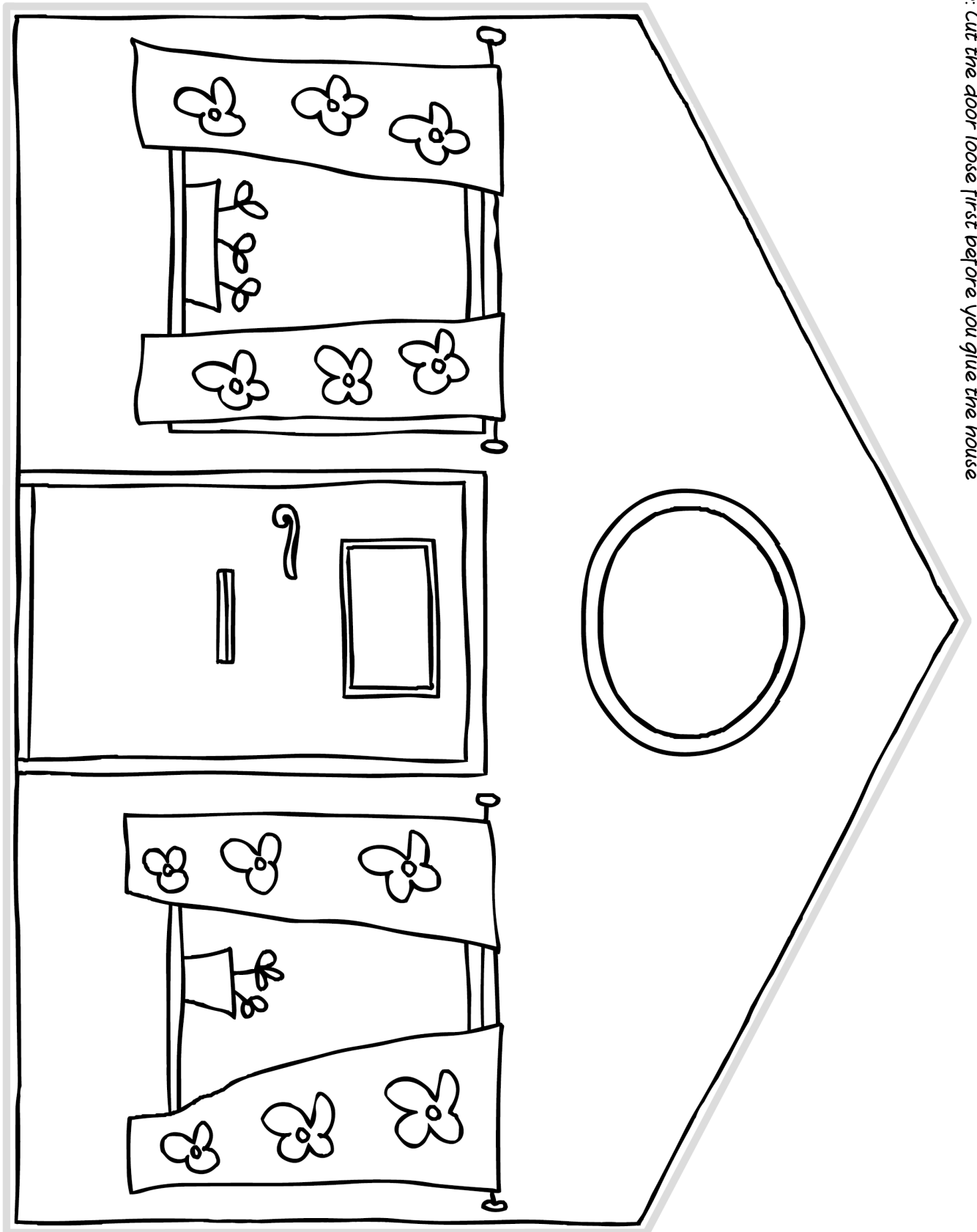

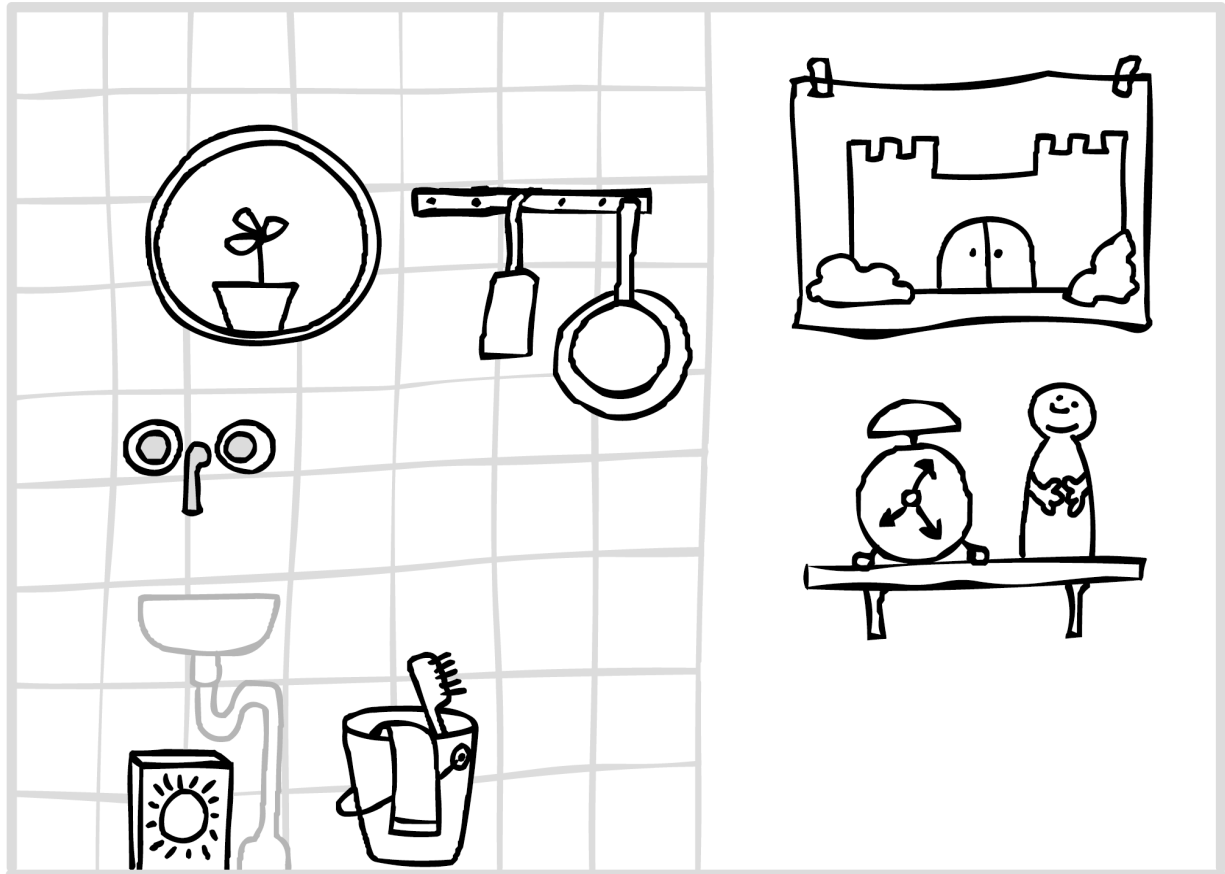

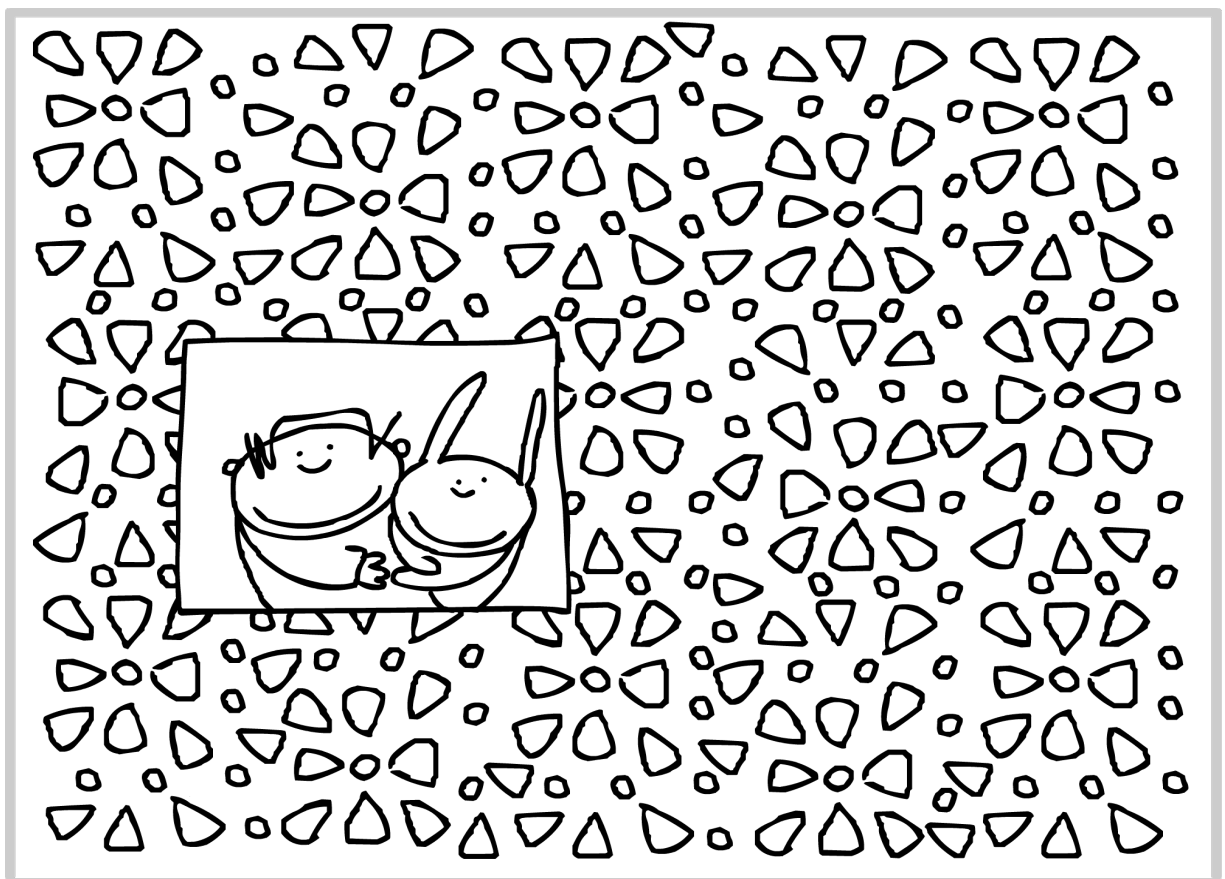

The kitchen and the bedroom wall

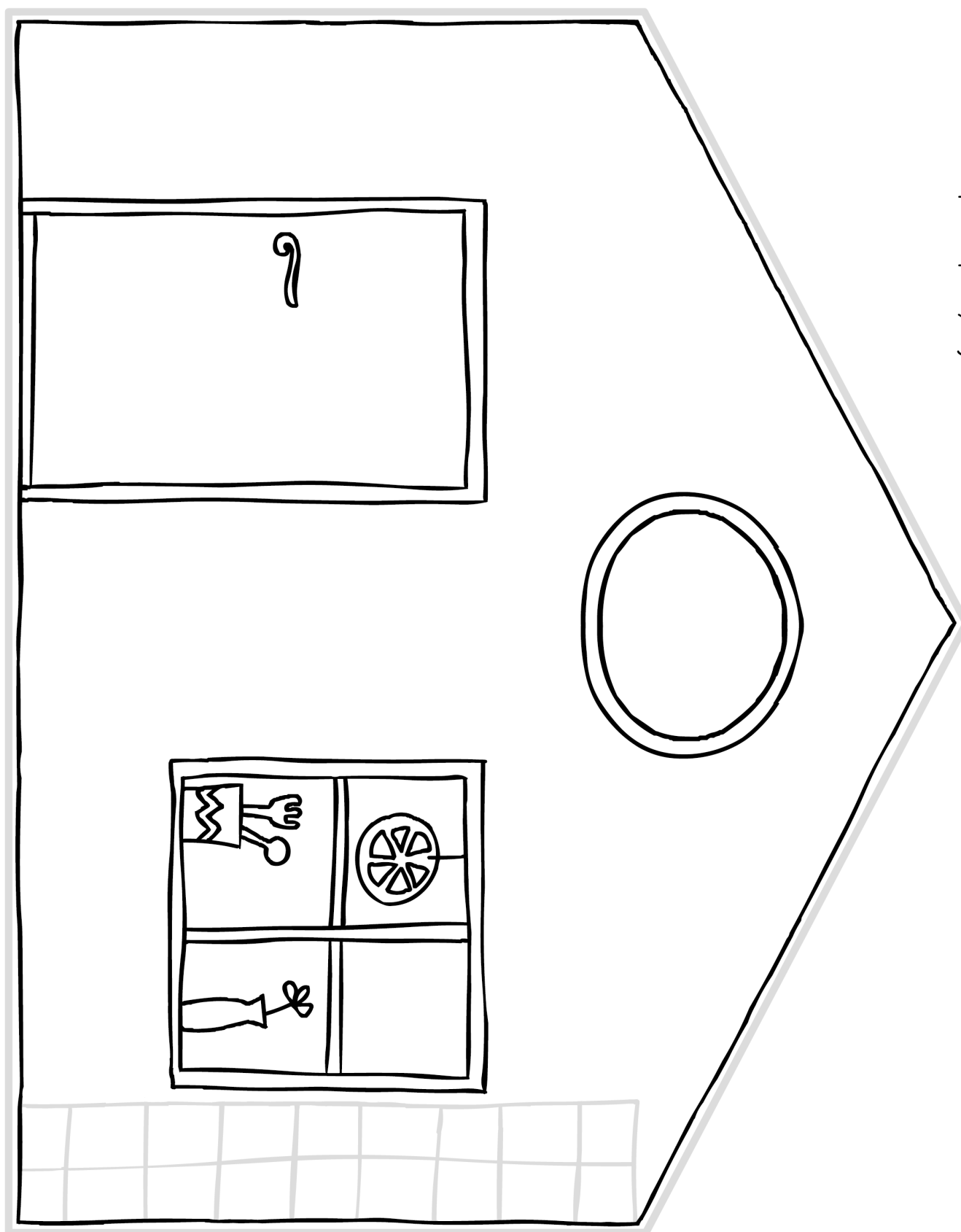


The wall of the living room

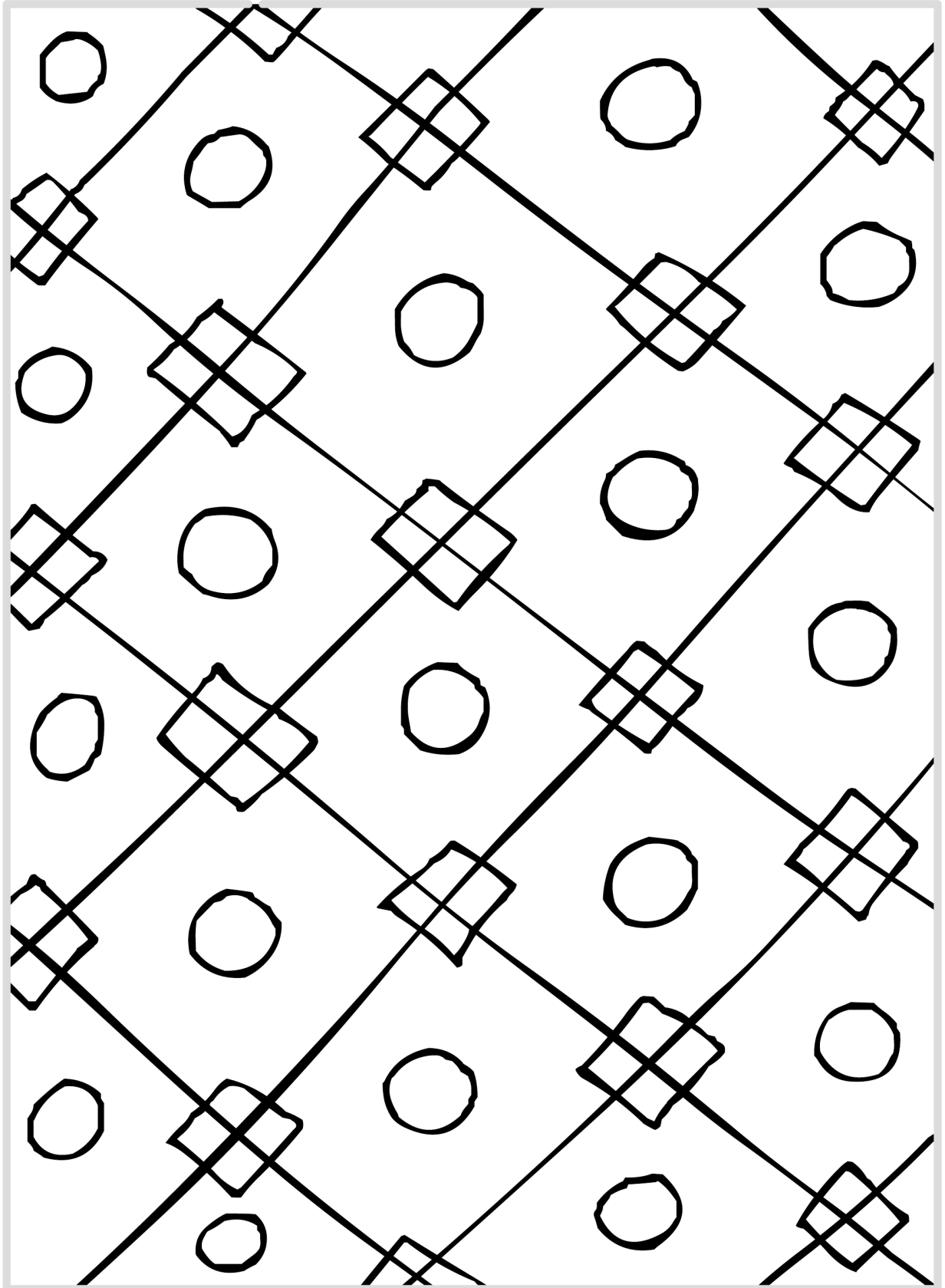

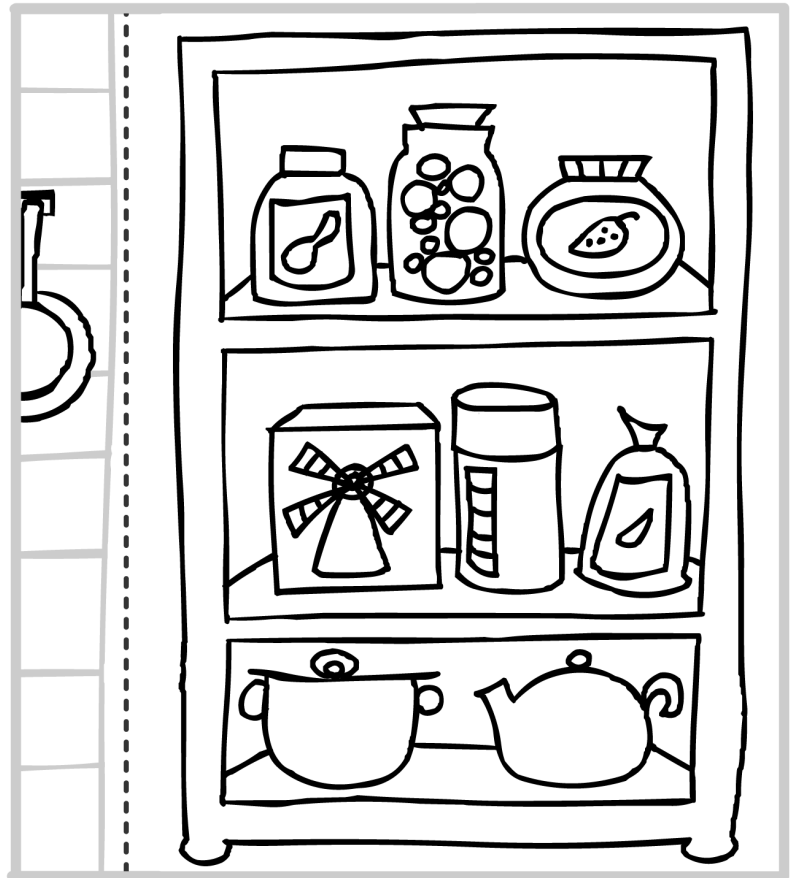
The floor in the house



Kitchen-bedroom partition wall

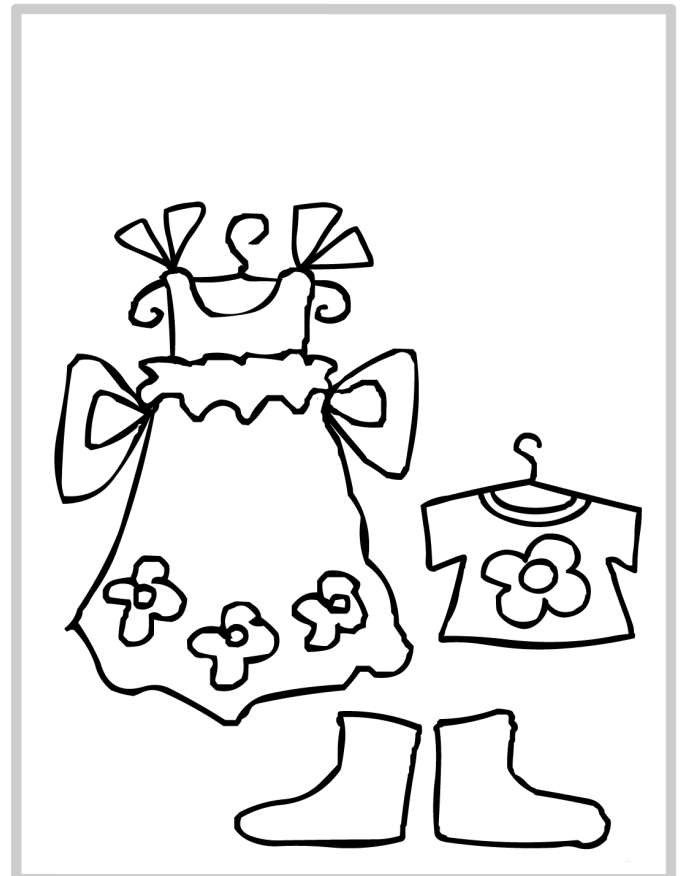

This partition wall is in the living room, so you have a kitchen side and a separate bedroom.

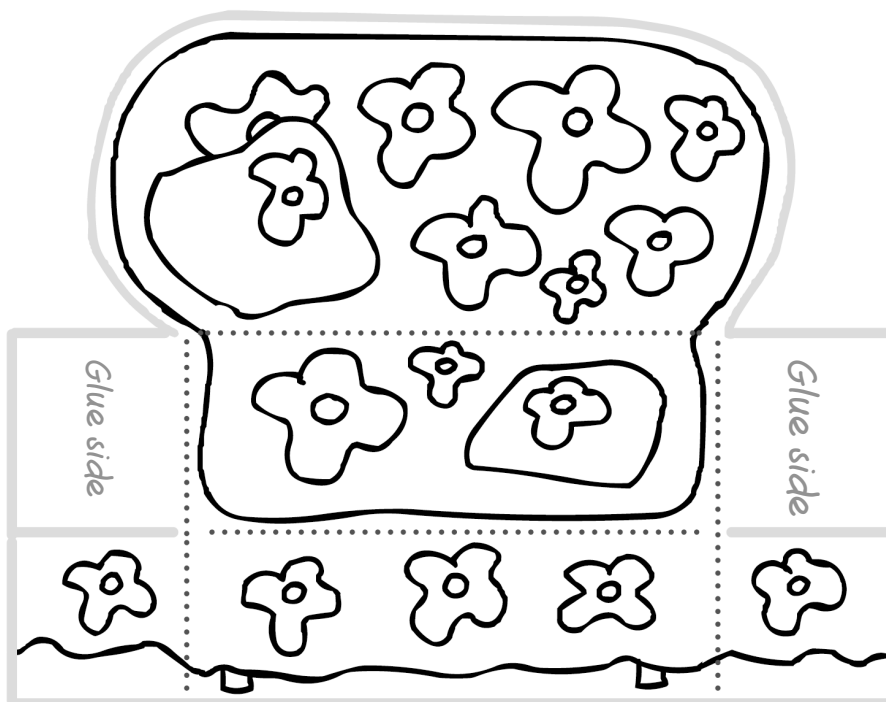
First, glue the side with the clothes to the back of the kitchen cabinet.
Then, glue the wall to the kitchen wall (page 11) in the house.



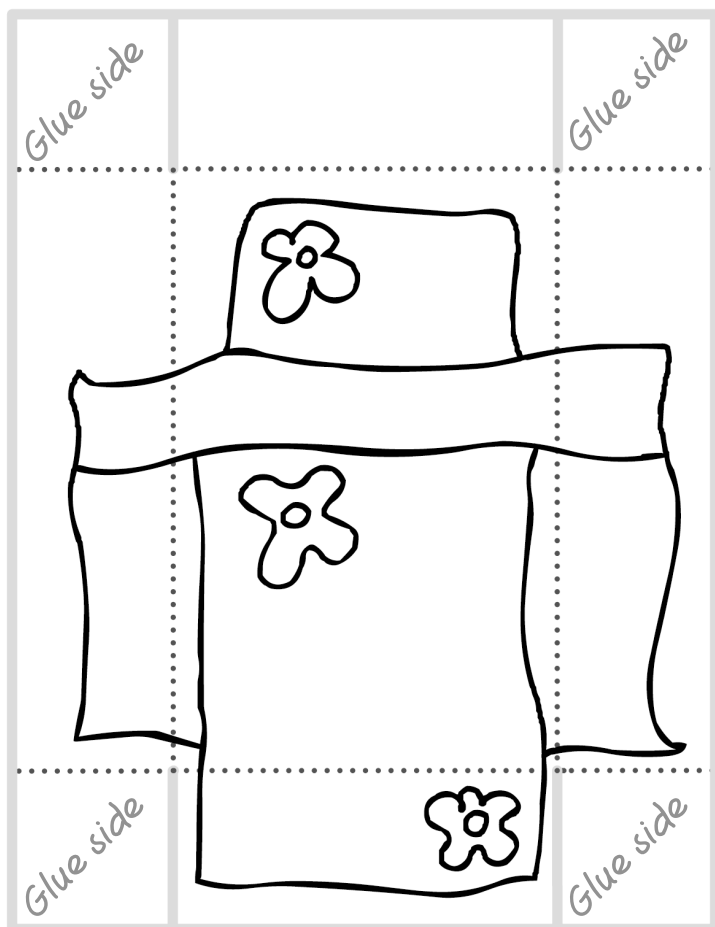

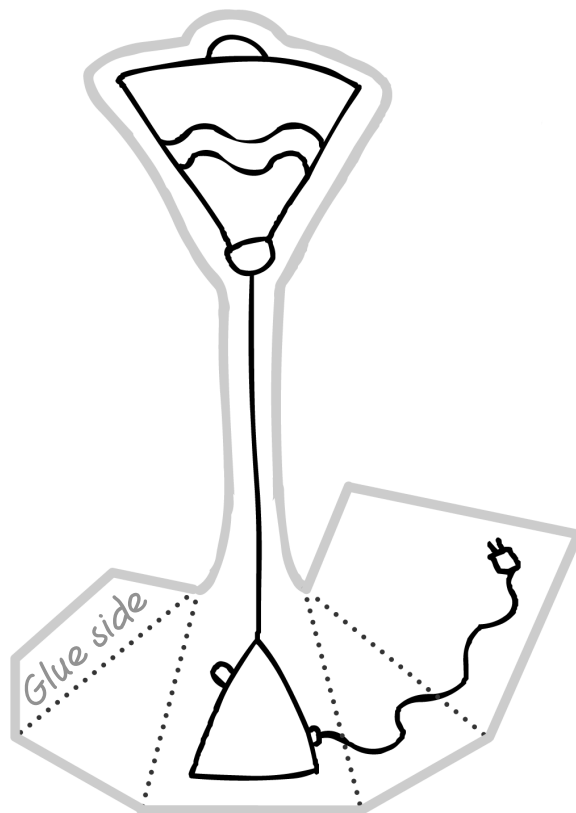

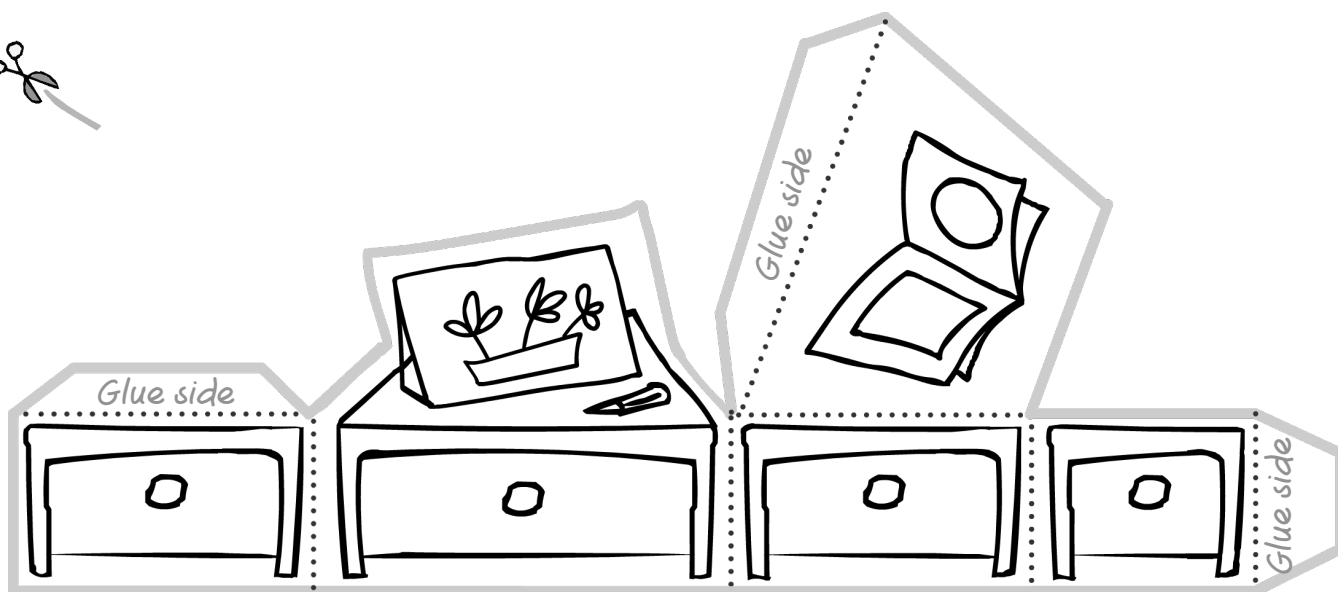

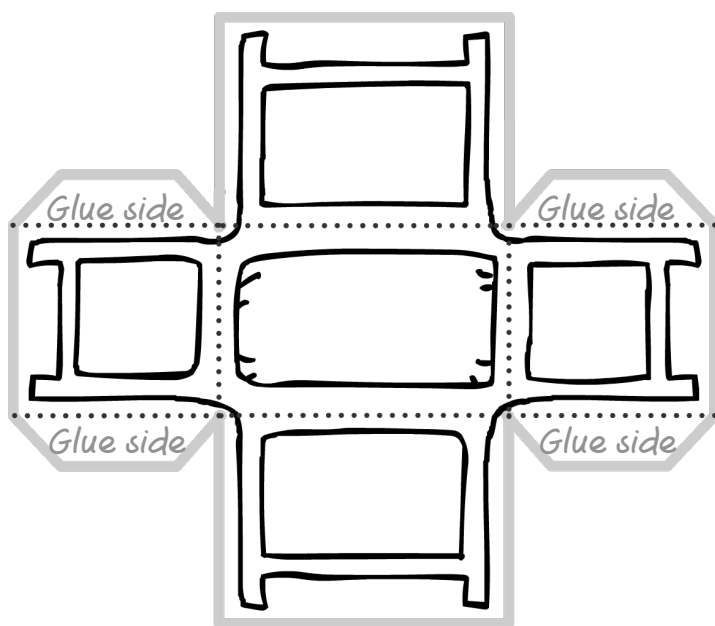
A corner cupboard with a door

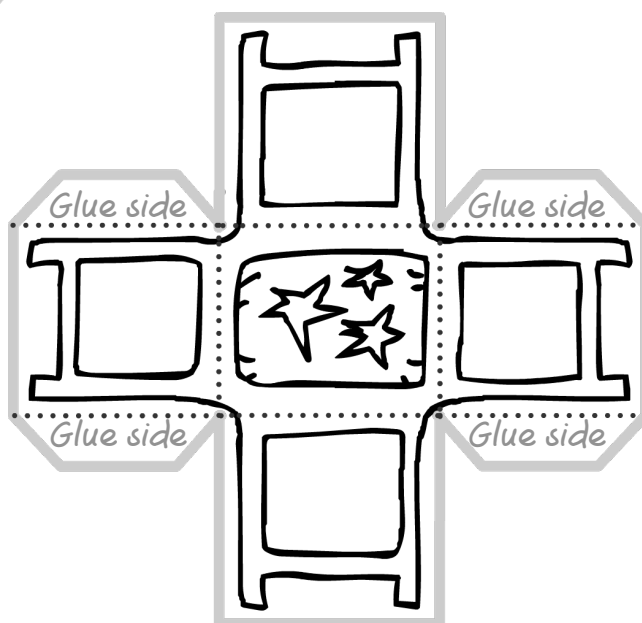


A side table

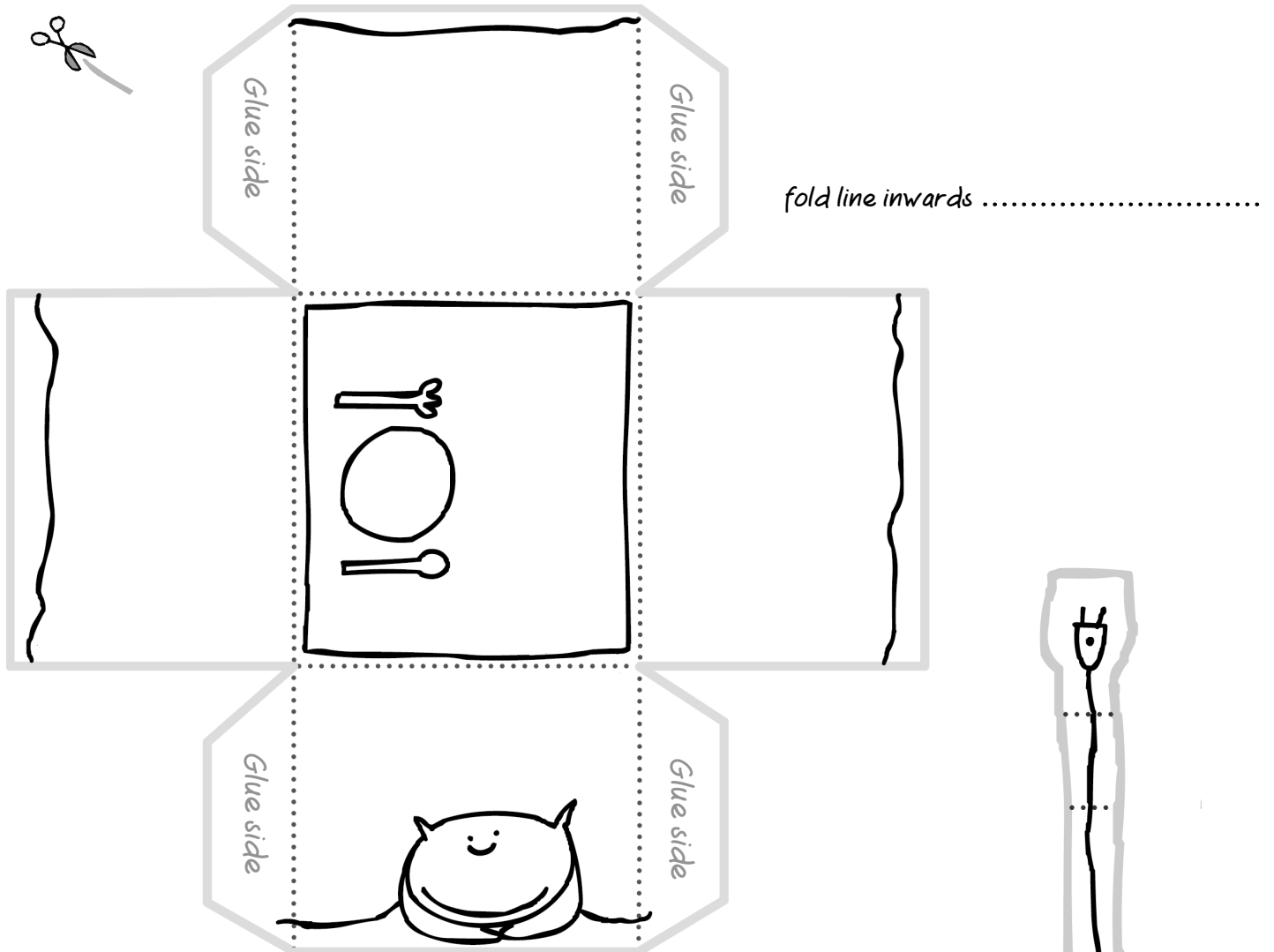


A stool for the table

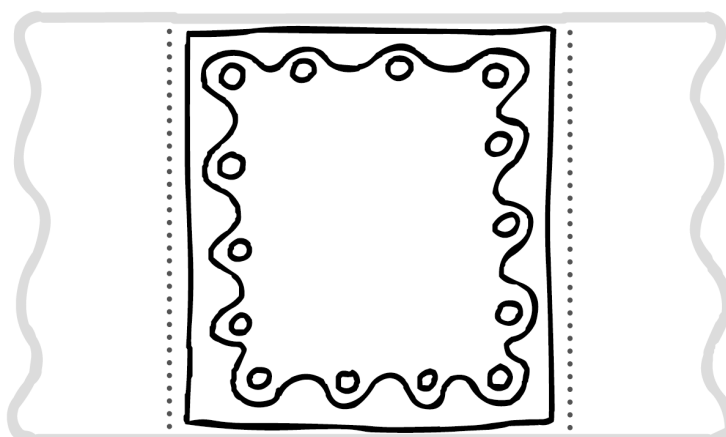

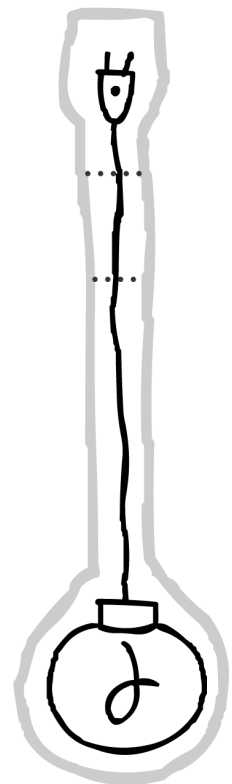

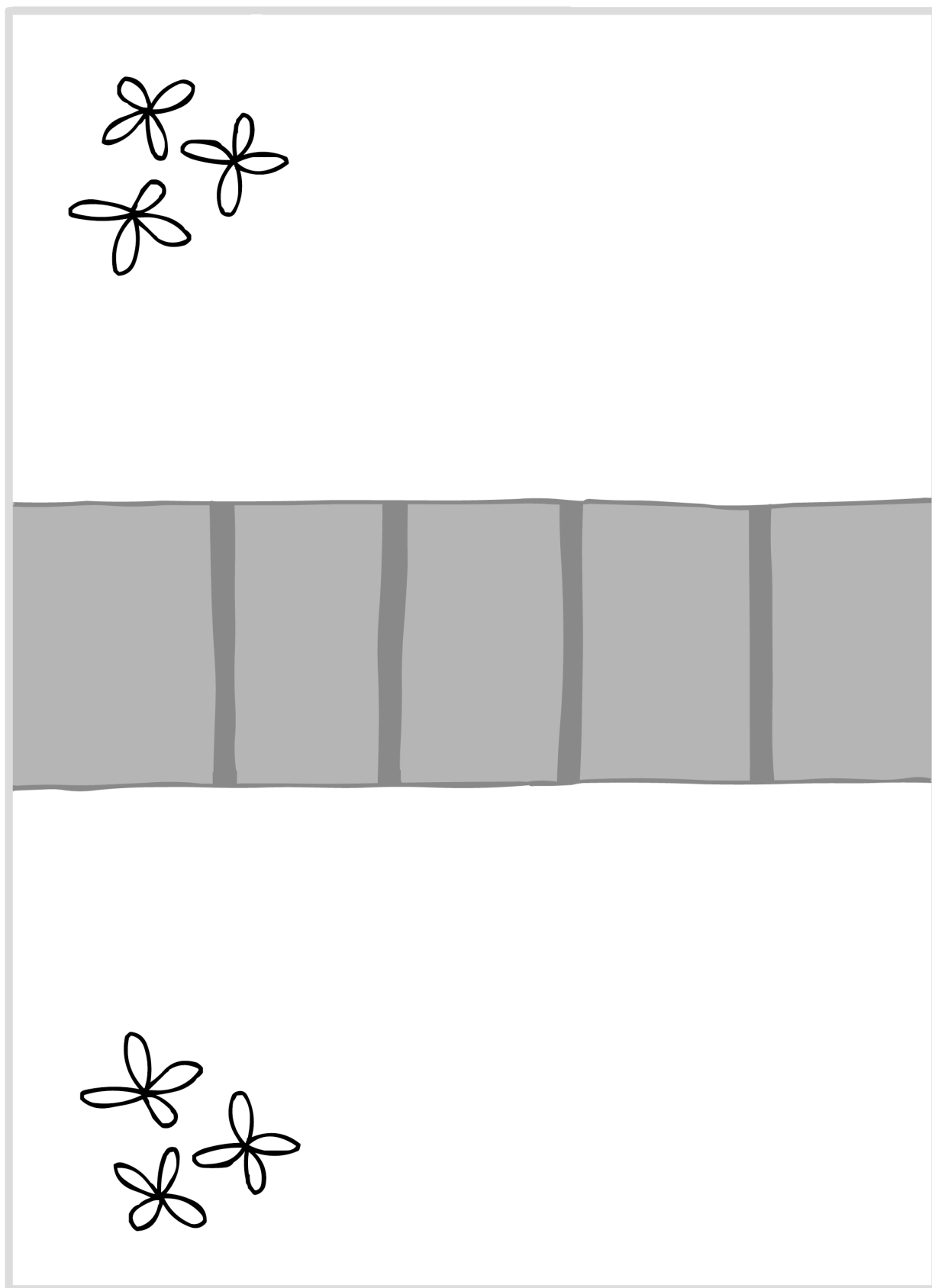

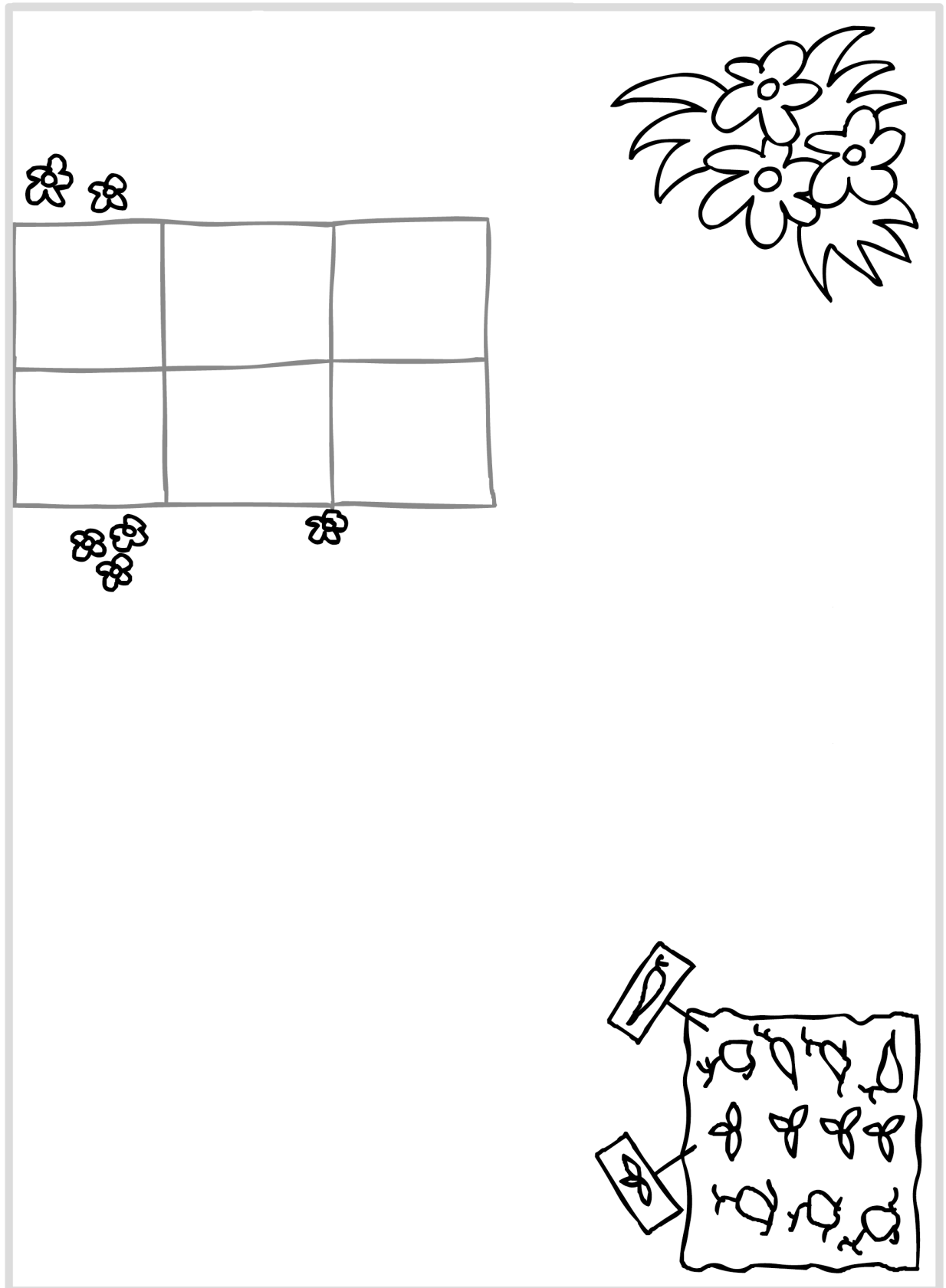

Hoe print en bouw je het Lassa huis?



Print the Lassa house preferably on sturdy A4 paper (160g). You can print at 100%. Coloring is easiest before assembling the house and furniture.

Building:

- 1) First, cut out the exterior parts (pages 1 to 4) of the house.
Place these (colored) in the correct position on the base plate (page 8).
Tape the four sides together. You can use glue or tape.
- 2) Cut out the interior parts (pages 10 to 12) of the house.
Tape these (colored) in place on the inside.
Cut out the front and back doors if necessary.
- 3) Tape the (colored) floor (page 13) to the house.
- 4) First, glue the two sides of the partition (page 14) together and then stick it to the inside of the house in the indicated spot in the kitchen.
- 5) The roof is loose, like a lid, so you can play in your own Lassa house.
