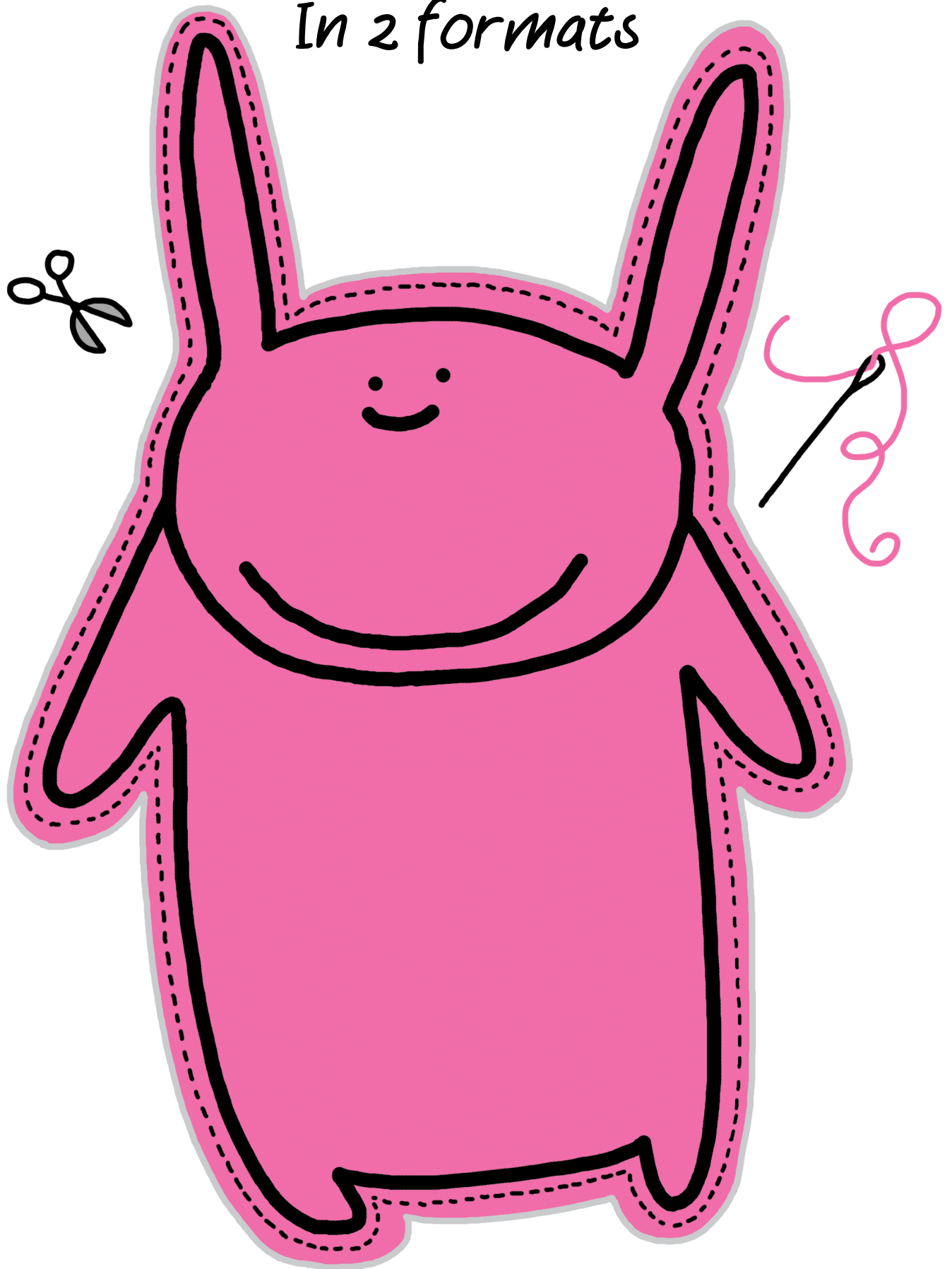
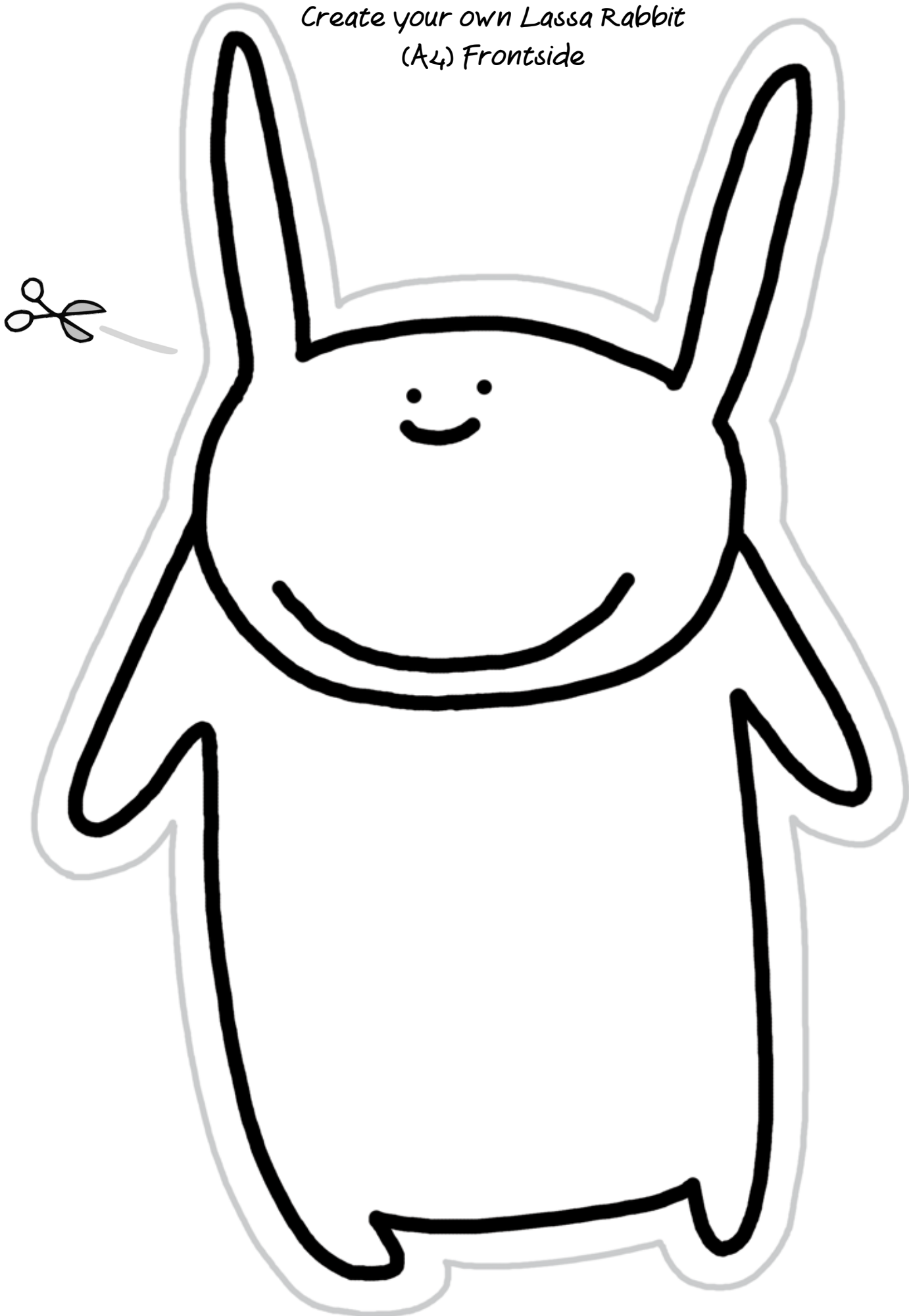

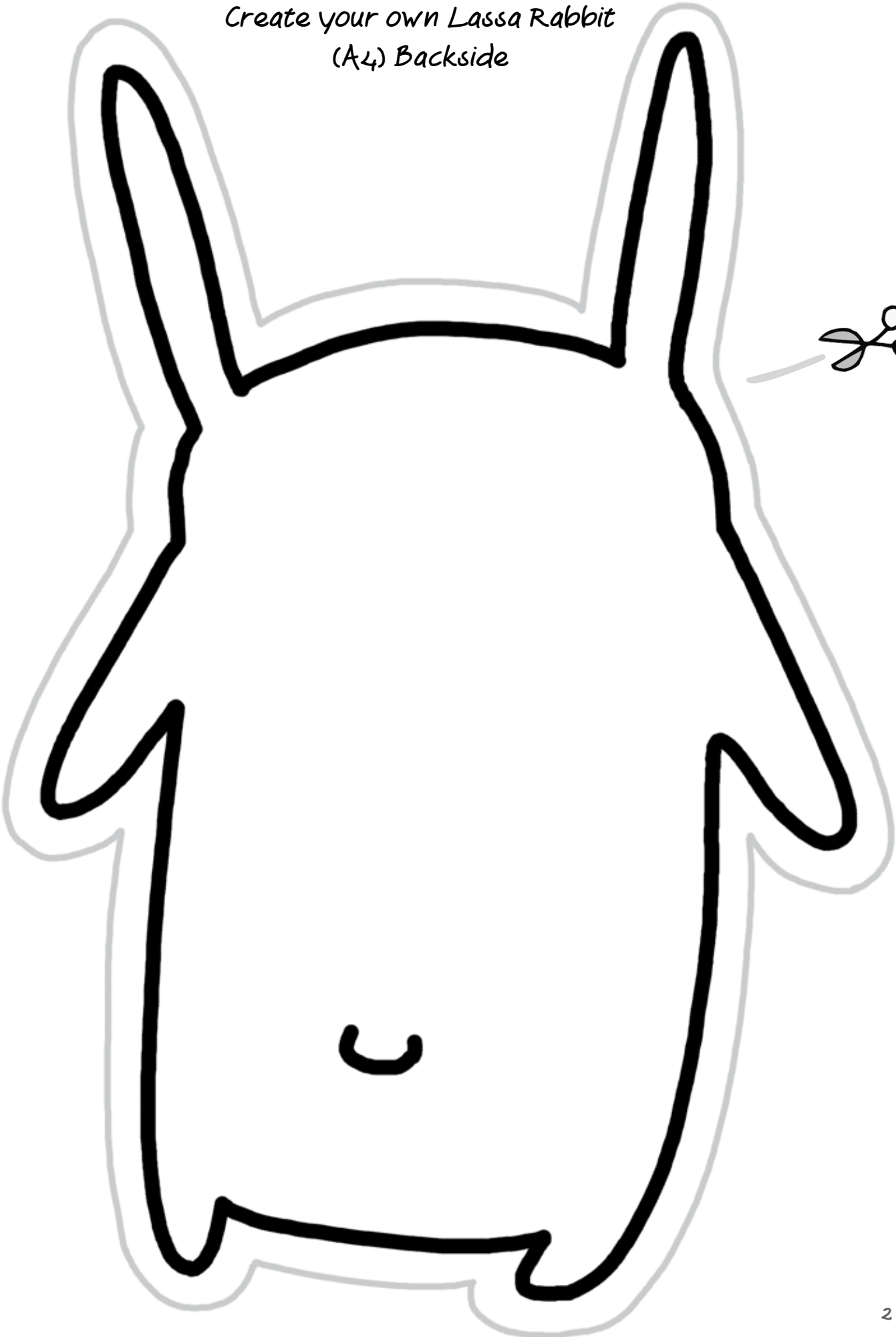
In 2 formats



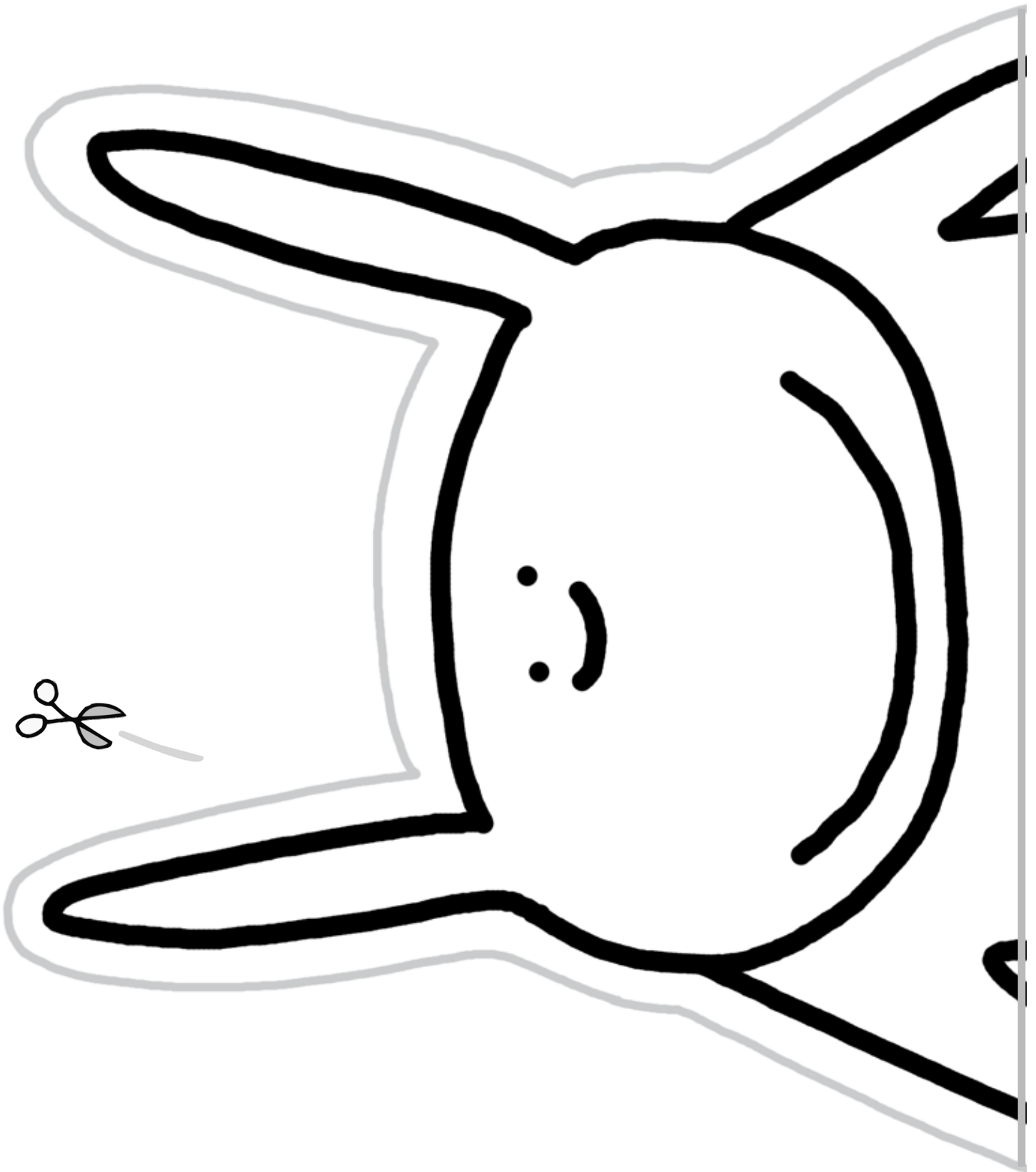
Create your own Lassa Rabbit

(A4) Backside



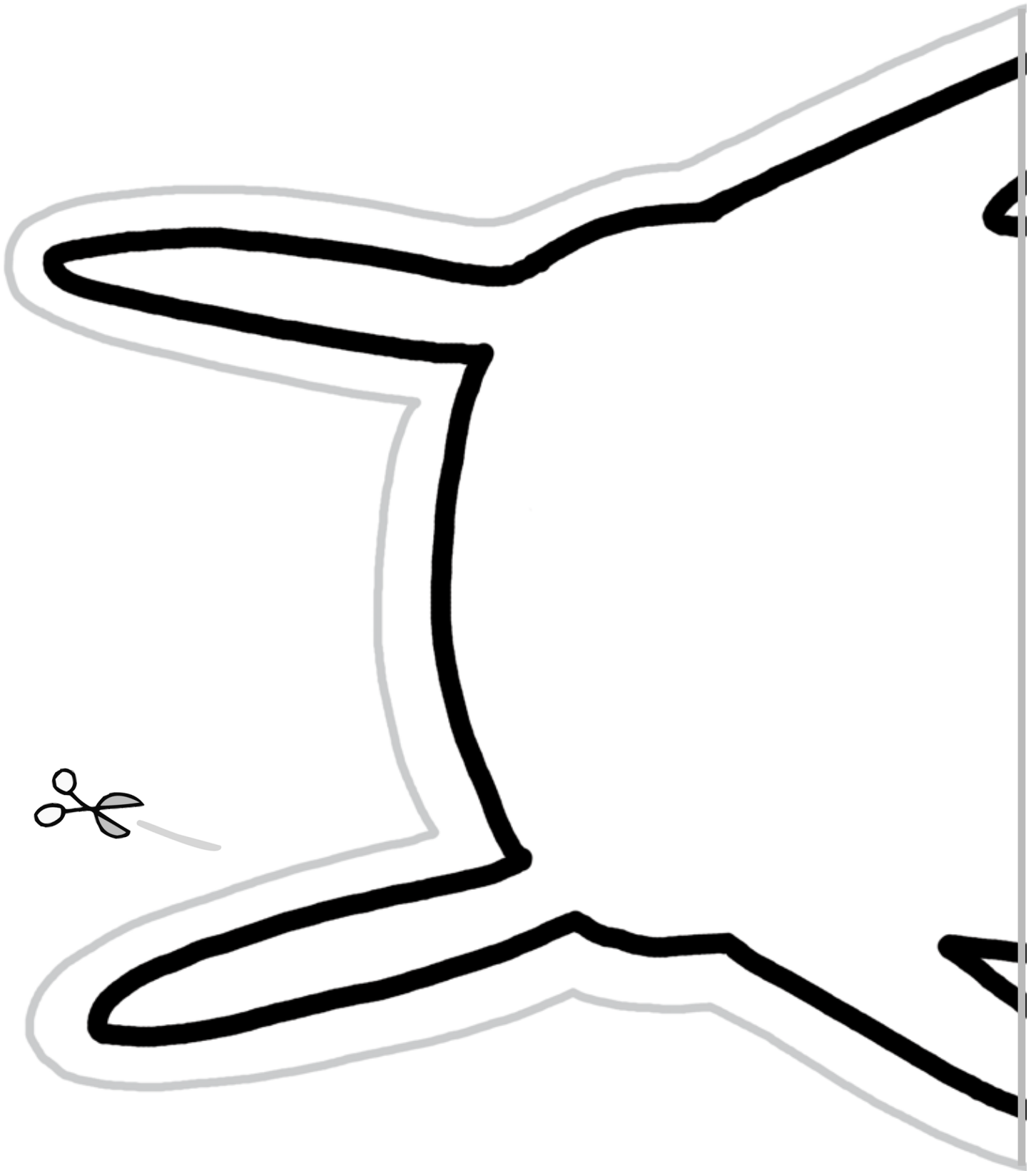

(A3) Frontside part 1



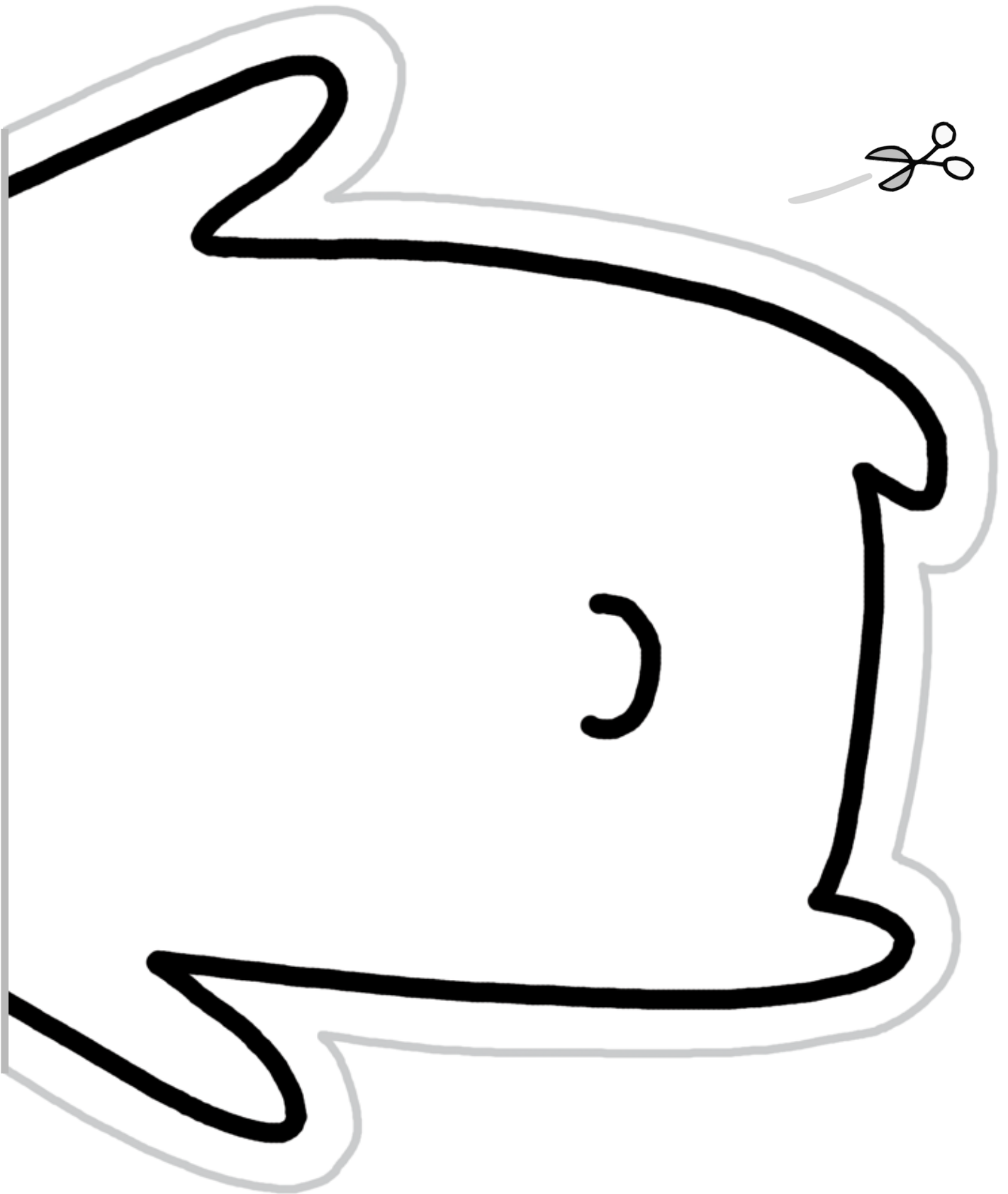

Create your own Lassa Rabbit

You will need:

- Scissors
- Thick Black felt-tip pen
- Soft pink fabric
- Cushion filling
- Sewing machine
- Pins
- Needle and thread

For A4 format:

Print pages 2 and 3 on A4.

Cut along the grey lines of the pattern.

For A3 format:

Print page 3 t/m 6 (A4)

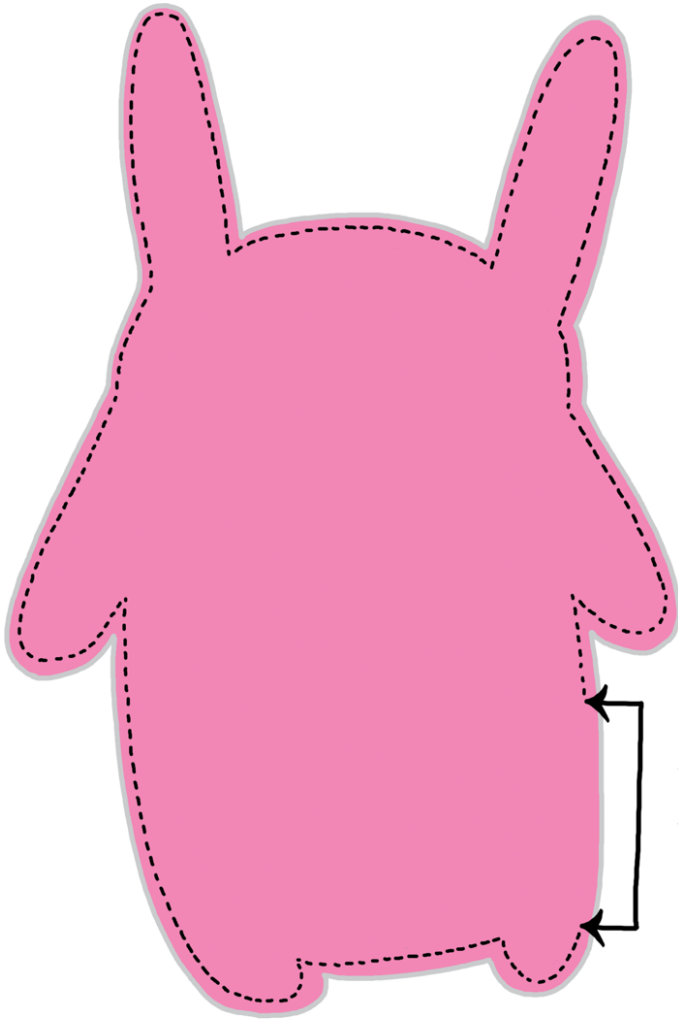
Cut the 4 parts along the grey lines of the pattern.

Create 1 frontside and 1 backside by adjusting and taping the 2 parts together.

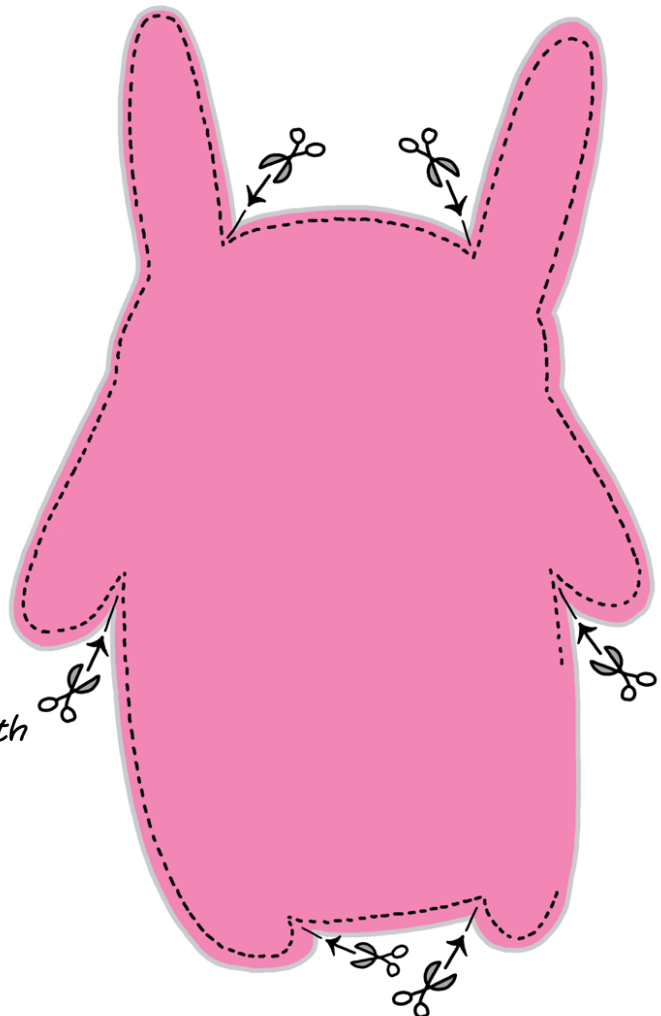
Method:

- Pin the patterns on the fabric.
 - Cut out both parts.
 - Draw with felt-tip pen Rabbit's face on the front.
 - Draw the tail on the backside.
 - You can create the face and tail also with embroidery on the fabric, use your drawing as a base.
 - Sew the front and back of Rabbit together with a straight stitch, the two sides with the drawings facing each other.
 - Leave one side open between the arm and foot.
- See Example A, on the next page.
- Cut the corners on the 6 spots for sharper edges.
- See example B on the next page.
- Turn your Rabbit inside out through the open side.
 - Fill Rabbit with cushion filling as firm as you want.
 - Close the gap on the side with needle and thread and your Rabbit is ready!

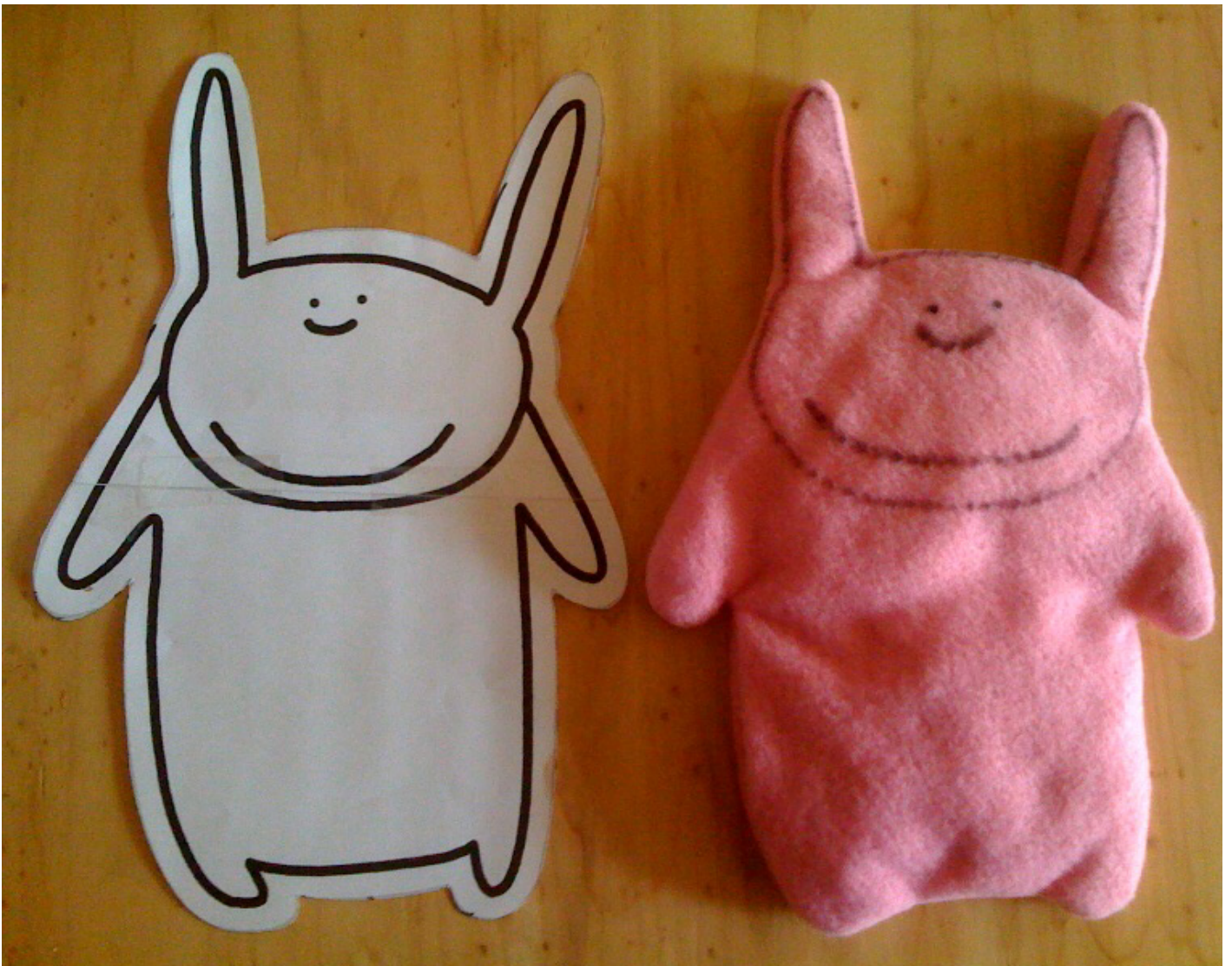


Example A.
